We also expect that our stakeholders will adopt these same standards in working with ENTRUST.

ENTRUST will therefore not tolerate any acts of bribery, or corruption in any form and has a 'zero tolerance' approach to any of these activities. In line with the requirements of the Bribery Act 2010, ENTRUST, our employees or persons acting on our behalf will never seek, accept, offer a bribe, gift, or other improper payment as a reward for improper performance of a relevant function, or activity.

At all times, individuals acting within the Landfill Communities Fund (LCF) sector should consider how their actions would be viewed if they were subject to independent scrutiny and review.
